Carson City, Lake Tahoe and Truckee Tour & Picnic LUNCH — Friday, June 15; 8:30 am - 3:30 pm \$60.00

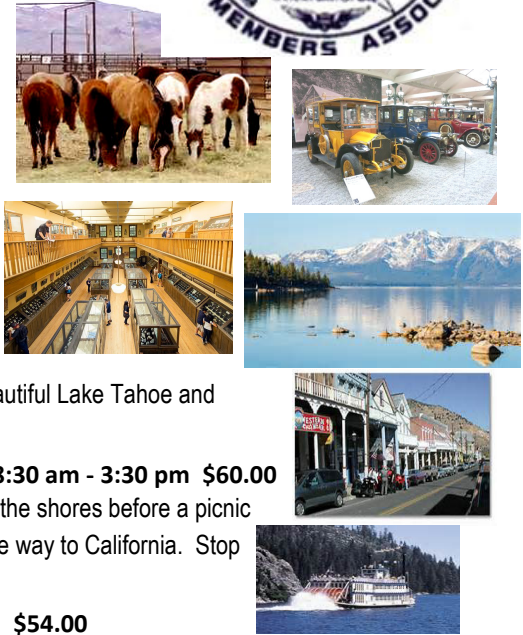
